Report Criminal Tax Evasion in an Instant

The Tax Recovery and Criminal Enforcement (TRaCE) Task Force, in conjunction with the Board of Equalization, is pleased to announce that its central intake system for reporting criminal tax evasion, labor fraud, piracy, counterfeiting, human trafficking and other economic crimes is now available and can be accessed via the Web or any mobile device. The public can now report a crime online through the Board of Equalization website at www.cdtfa.ca.gov/trace.

The online form allows you to attach documents, files or pictures in support of the crime reported. You will receive a reference number when you file a report, which can be used to provide additional information any time after the submission of your original report.
