The word "carrier" as used in Paragraph A-1-(c) of Ruling 55 is defined as a person or firm engaged in the business of transporting for compensation tangible personal property owned by other persons. The term includes both common carriers and contract carriers.

Examples of carriers are railroad companies, trucking companies, airline companies, steamship companies, express companies, drayage companies, and the United States Mail.
